

King Square Community Nursery Immunisation Policy

The nursery will ask parents to provide immunisation details for their children on enrolment and to inform the office of any subsequent immunisations. The following information will be displayed on our health and wellbeing notice board and parents can ask for a copy, it will be updated as required: it is derived from the NHS website and provides details of the current UK immunisation schedule, as set out below.

MMR and Immunisations

- MMR is a highly effective vaccine with an outstanding safety record.
- On admission parents complete an immunisation records for children in their care.
- Nurseries should make parents aware that there may be children in the nursery who have not had MMR or other vaccines. They should not, however, disclose any information about the vaccination status of individual children.
- Nurseries should **not** exclude children who have not had MMR or other vaccines.
